As most of you know, in July last year, my family and I cycled from Lands End to John O'Groats. Reflecting on the experience of planning that journey, and bringing it to a successful conclusion, encouraged me to organise the LyCiG Local course which we did jointly before Easter, and to plan for growth in our two churches. In July, a small steering group met for the first time, to review where we're up to with the plans we made earlier in the year, and to begin to think about how we continue to move forward. It was very encouraging to realise that many of the short-term things we planned before Easter have already happened (eg the Pentecost invitation service at St James', and the men's evening), and that we are moving ahead with medium-term and ongoing plans (eg a group has completed Christianity Explored over the last few months, and another group has been meeting for Bible Study). And don't forget to praise and thank the Lord for all that he's doing amongst us to grow his kingdom!

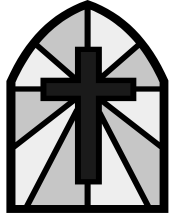
